Leadership classes slated to start in April 2010

Leadership Hancock County's steering committee is springing into action to tap into the skills and knowledge of this area's current leaders while making the county a more vigorous and prosperous place to live and work. The program's mission is the train both emerging and established leaders to guide the future development of the community. The Leadership Hancock County program, mapped out by the steering committee and the Hancock County Health Coalition, will be a nine-month course, with monthly workshops beginning the third Wednesday of April and running through December. The date of the first meeting will be April 21, 2010. Each participant will pay a \$250.00 registration fee for the course. In return they will receive leadership instruction in a variety of fields of expertise. The program is being coordinated by the Hancock County Health Coalition and Stephanie Lamar, GRADD's- Regional Health Network Director, Aging, Health & Social Services Department. The programming for each session will consist of several general areas of emphasis: Introduction and Orientation, Economic Development, Agriculture, Tourism, Health and Wellness, Local Government, Community Agencies and Services, and Public Education. The programming will focus on rural economic development with associated curriculum aimed at aiding current and prospective leaders in developing knowledge and skills necessary in making Hancock County more competitive in the future. During the course participants will be required to attend 9 sessions, one per month. Classes will be held at various locations throughout the county, with each session beginning at 9 a.m. and ending no later than 4:00 p.m. The organizations steering committee includes: Karen Bolin- chairperson, Lisa Powers- president, Lisa Hagman- vice-president, Rick Embry- treasurer, and Lorri Oliver- secretary. The Leadership Hancock County program gives participants the opportunity to learn more about, and become better associated with, the varying aspects of the community that must intertwine and function with one another for improvements to become reality. A tremendous range of diversity in the classes brings together people from different backgrounds to offer their individual opinions, learn more about the strengths and weaknesses of the community, and explore possible solutions to economic and/or social problems. The Leadership class of 2010 will consist of 10-15 participants. Applications will be accepted from residents of Hancock County or anyone who works in Hancock County. Applications for the leadership class are available by email or standard mail.
